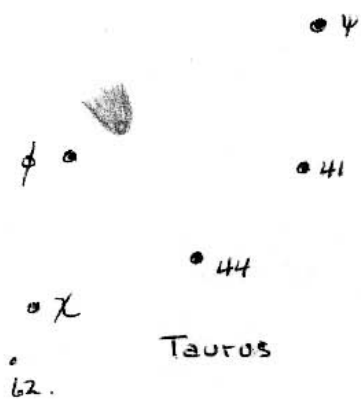


Comet Seki-Lines (1962 c)

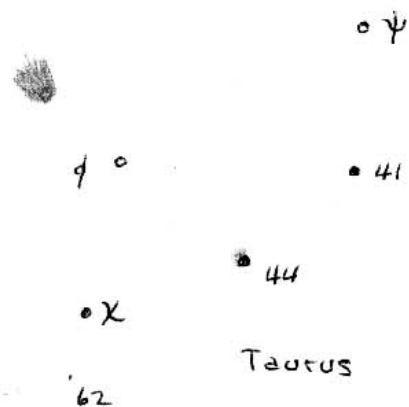

7 X 50 Binoculars

Comments:

Head of comet on line connecting ϕ and ψ Tauri, about 10° from ϕ Tauri. Head had bright nucleus.

Short, bushy tail $1\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ long (with averted vision slightly longer).

Slightly brighter than ϕ Tauri which is shown in Norton's as 5th magnitude.

Located comet but poor transparency made observation difficult.
