Here are the June Negative Reports. I must apologize for the scarcity of observations. - Our section has one other besides myself & he has been under medical care the last few months.

I spent the last week in June on an island half way up Georgian Bay and had two beautiful nights. I have never seen the dark nebulae stand out so clearly. On those two nights I am sure I located Comet 1961 e (Hansen), using 7x50 Binoculars. On June 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 PM E.S.T., I was looking at M51 through an 8" S&S reflector<sup>(125X)</sup> & noticed a star ~~on~~ on the edge of NGC-5194. I could not see it at 12:00 P.M. Have you heard any report of something like this? I would estimate its magnitude at 11.0 (approx.). I was exposing a negative around that time but did not pick up anything unusual.

Our Centre is planning an exhibit at Oak Hall in Magog Falls on August 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> and I would appreciate your advice you could give re some display about our Comet & Moon Section.
