Thenk you for your letter of March 6, and for the reports. I made a number of observations of the nova about the same time as you. Towards the end of Feb. it appeared near 5 th magnitude, and was fading slowly, but with an occasional increase in brightness of about 0.2 mag.

I made only one observation of the comet with my binoculars. I did not have a good view of the western sky from the spot for my

8" reflector.

A new comet is visible, but is not bright enough for a

formal announcement. (Alcock 63b)
