Dear Mr. How,

I have been able to get two photographs of Comet Kletan, 1966 (B) in the last month. The first was taken on Aug. 19/20 when it was about magnitude 10.6. At that time we barely visible with an eight inch, f5 refractor at the A small Dome. The second photo was taken Sept 9/10, again at the A small Dome.

The questions are as follows:

The positions for the comet were taken
from the image of the comet on the photographic
plate, with use of comparison stars; and not from
an ephemeris - so they could be off slightly.
I've enclosed a photo of the comet, taken
Aug 19/20.

you
