I thank you for the literature on Expo and Centennial Celebrations. We plan on staying on de Tracy St for a week following the General Assembly. I hope to get in touch with you then.

Enclosed are negative search reports for April 1967. Things are fairly slow so far this year. I have spent a few hours on Mars, but in this locality moments of good seeing are not very frequent. I was fortunate to be part of a group watching the grazing occultation of Eta Leonis. It was quite a striking sight with four distinct disappearances. We timed with C40 time signals and a small portable tape recorder. This event ~~occurred~~ occurred about two miles north of Niagara Falls, along a line that just about passed through my back yard!

I looked for Nova Hercules 1963 a few nights ago when it was very clear but could detect no sign of it. The 12th mag. star near it was fairly easily seen. I keep checking it occasionally, hoping it might start brightening again.
