Dear Mr. Low,

Sorry about the delay in getting these reports to you - time seems to be in short supply these days!

Negative search slips for Nov. & Dec. 1967, and Jan. & Feb. 1968 are enclosed.

The observations (such as they are) of Nooa Delphinus 1967 & Comet 1967-II are also enclosed on separate sheets.

January was a bad month for clouds in this area, and in addition I seem to have had time available.

On Feb. 25<sup>th</sup> I took a time exposure of the comet but have not yet finished the roll. It is quite faint and may not have been registered on the film. My estimates of comet brightness seem to be out quite a bit from the reported brightness. It seems consistently fainter to me - around 0

There is a chance that I may be travelling west this spring, so I may be able to make it to the General Assembly in Calgary.
