Thank you for your letter of 29 October. I, too, heard about a new comet several days ago, but am still waiting for an ephemeris. I will send you a copy of the ephemeris when I receive it.

Comet Abe has been around for a few months, and was visible in binoculars for a while. It is near the sun now, and is fading, but you may pick it up with a 4 or 6 inch telescope in the morning sky towards the end of the year. Here is the ephemeris, with approximate magnitudes:
