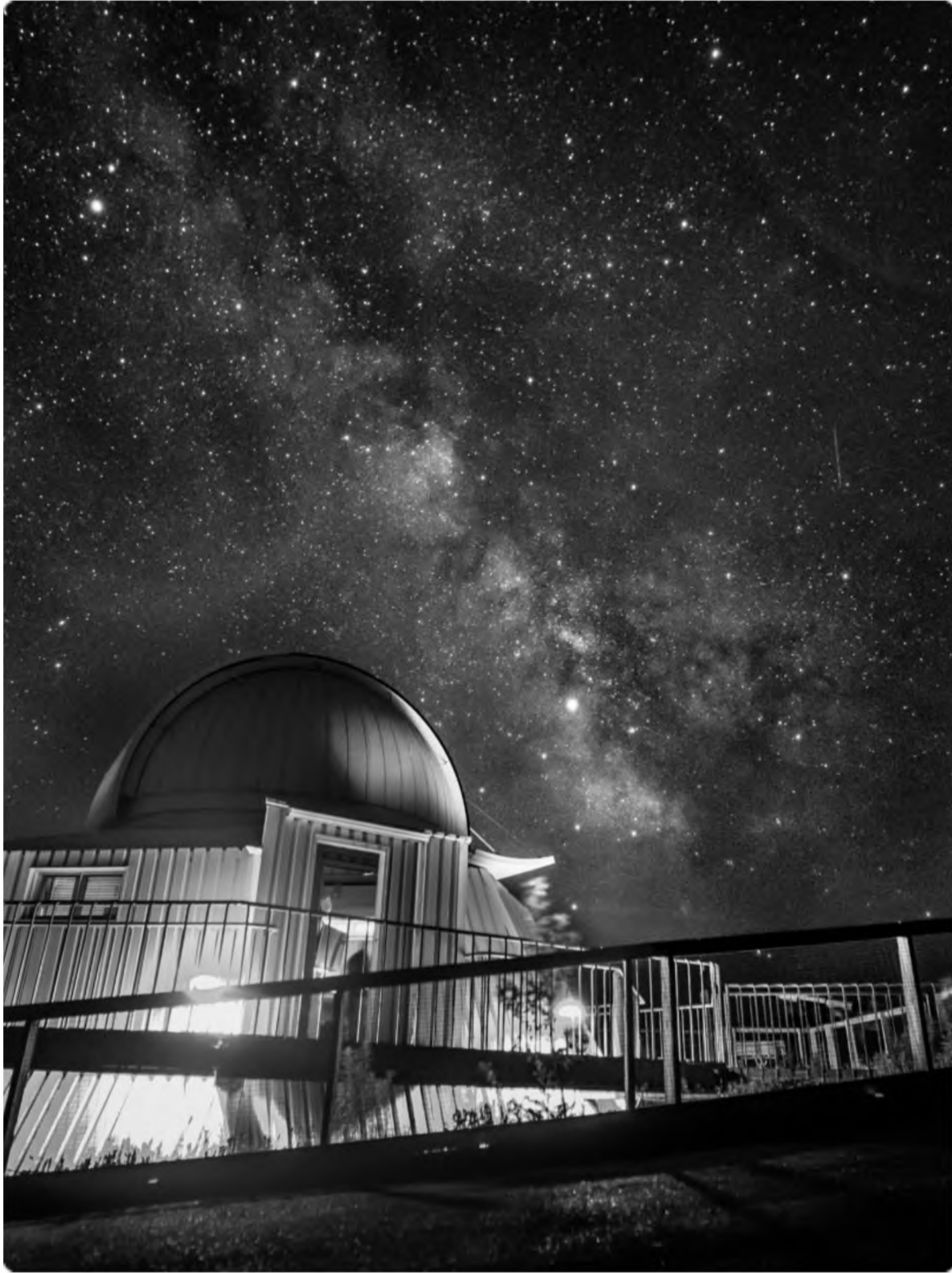

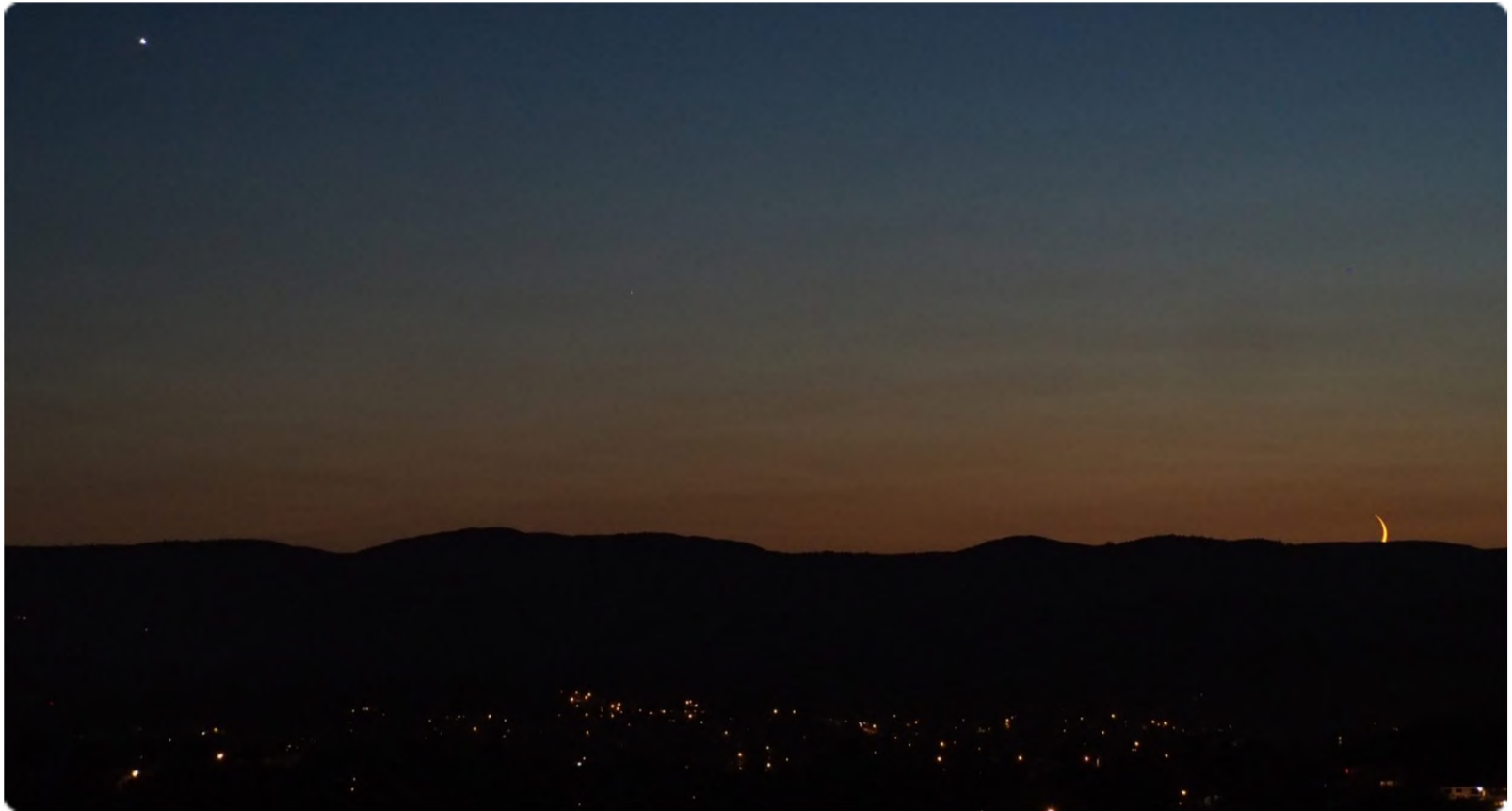

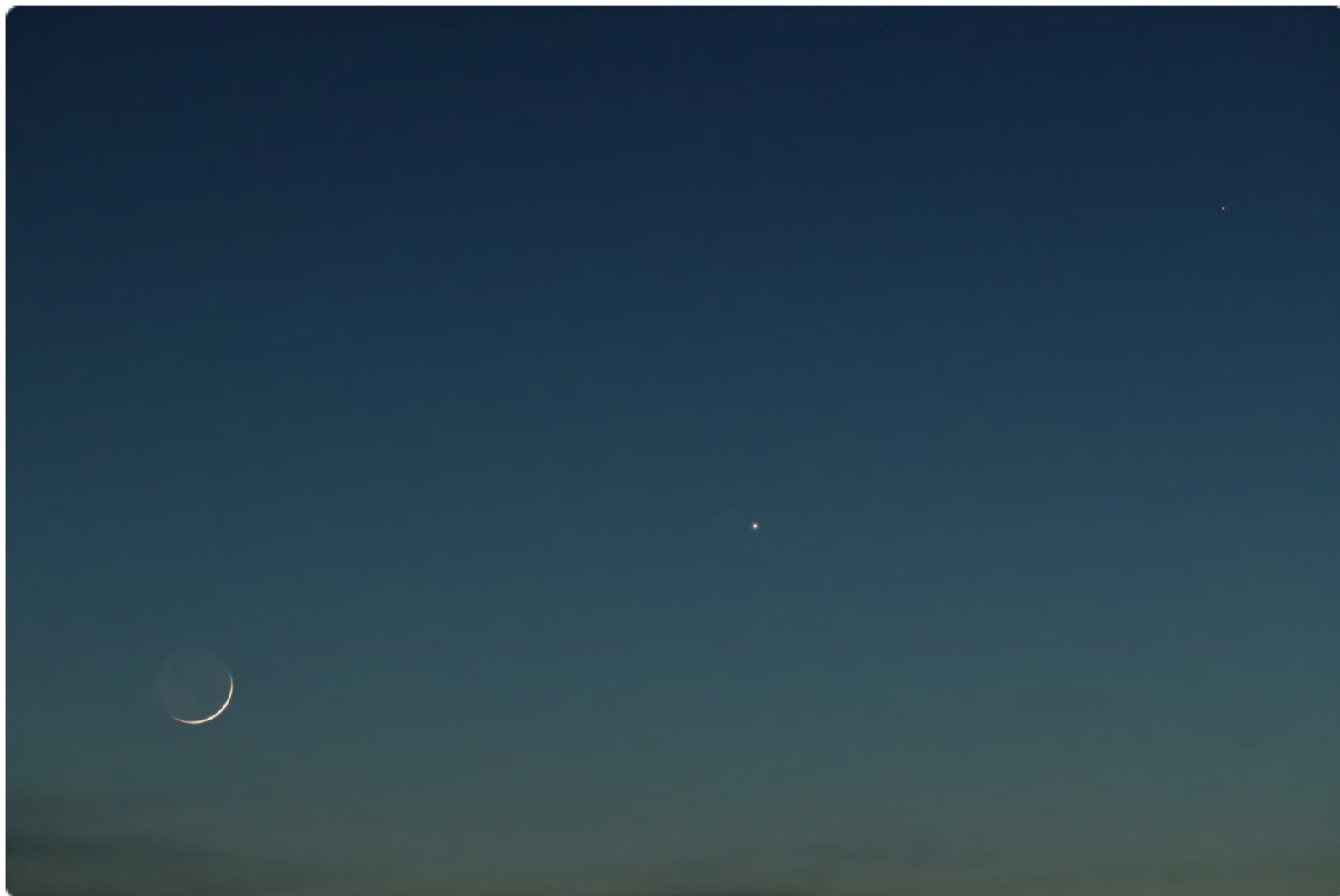

A thin, 1.4 day old (2.3% illuminated) crescent Moon joins Venus (centre) and Mercury (upper right) in the evening sky on March 18, 2018. The unlit part of the Moon can be faintly seen due to Earthshine (sunlight reflected off the Earth). Moon distance: 382,590 km, 1.28 light seconds Venus distance: 242.2 million km, 13.47 light minutes Mercury: 122.6 million km, 6.82 light minutes. Technical details: Canon EOS 6D Mark II, f/8.0, 238mm, 1/15 sec., ISO 12800
