

National Council Meeting Highlights - June 2, 2007 (NC072)

The RASC's National Council held a meeting via teleconference on Saturday, June 2. <u>Flash minutes</u> [2] are available on the Society's Web site. The meeting was convened out of the regular schedule in order to deal with three specific and time-sensitive issues. The replacement for our **membership handling system** was approved, as were two award nominees for the <u>Service Award</u> [3] and one for the <u>Simon</u> <u>Newcomb Award</u> [4]. Also approved was the formation of a special committee of National Council – the **Board Pilot Committee** (BPC). This committee will see seven Society members elected to help the Executive manage the business of the Society, and to develop a budget and operating plan for 2008. Complete details for this important committee are outlined below.

There are also over 35 contributed papers and posters from members of the three organizations.

Call for Nominations - RASC Board Pilot Committee

The Board Pilot Committee (BPC) is a special committee of National Council with a term beginning June 28, 2007 and lasting until June 30, 2008. The Committee is made up of the Executive and seven other members of the Society to be elected at the General Assembly in Calgary. The BPC is to:

- handle the Society's ongoing business and ensure that existing programs and services continue to be delivered to members, Centres, and customers;
- develop the 2008 budget and operational plan for the Society for review and approval by National Council by November 2007;
- address key issues such as membership growth and retention, implementation of the new membership handling software, and volunteerism in the Society; and
- begin work on a long-term strategic plan for the Society, in consultation with Council, the Centres, National Office, members, customers, other astronomy groups, and other stakeholders.

The Society is seeking enthusiastic and energetic members to submit their names for election to this important committee. The committee will meet frequently in person and by teleconference and it is anticipated that all members of the BPC will be tasked with work to complete between meetings. Any member of the Society may nominate themselves for this Committee by submitting a **Candidate's Statement** [10]. The nomination deadline is June 21, 2007.

New Administrative System Approved

After an intensive search process the Society has approved the purchase of a new administrative system to keep up with the expanding needs of the membership. The new system will replace customized software that has been used for membership handling since 1997.

Project Sponsor and 1st Vice-President, **David Lane**, noted that the new system incorporates many outof-the-box features that will allow the Society to better serve its members via the Web. Implementation will begin in June 2007 with back-office components and infrastructure. A new member portal and eStore should be available by early 2008.
